CODE OF CONDUCT AND OPERATIVE PROVISIONS STUDENTS HOUSED IN THE FACILITIES OF THE OPERA UNIVERSITARIA COVID19 EMERGENCY

1. *General provisions for all lodgers (student halls and flats)*

- Ensure a continuous exchange of air in the rooms by leaving the windows open as much as possible.
- Adopt the normal rules of social distancing (distance of at least one meter and avoid any direct contact).
- For those who share the bathroom with other people:
 - a) Clean with hygienic products
 - b) Do not share towels, soap, etc.
 - c) Regularly wash clothes, bedding and towels in the washing machine.
- Do not share items.
- In the kitchens, make sure that there is distance, hygiene, no sharing of objects, good food preservation.

2. *Specific provisions for student residence (San Bartolameo and Mayer)*

COMMON PLACES

- Ensure social distancing both inside and outside the building.
- Ensure a continuous exchange of air in the rooms by leaving the windows open as much as possible.

STUDY ROOMS

- Access is allowed to the study rooms within the maximum number of people indicated by the signs, guaranteeing a distance of at least 1 meter between people.

COMMON KITCHENS

Meal preparation

- Air the room frequently.
- Wash hands thoroughly before entering the kitchen.
- Always maintain a social distance of at least 1 meter from others present and observe the maximum number of people who may enter the space indicated by the signs.
- Carefully disinfect work surfaces before preparing your meal.
- Use only your own crockery and cutlery.
- After the consumption of your meal, remove your crockery and cutlery from the worktops/fireplaces, which should be washed and stored in the room.

Meal consumption

- Position tables so that the distance between the back of one chair and the back of the other chair is greater than 1 m and that those facing each other are at least 1 m apart, including to the sides. It is advisable to use staggered seating.
- Meals will no longer be delivered to positive guests to their own rooms. We thus kindly ask you to organize yourselves through delivery services or by asking support to friends and/or other guests.

Appendix: General precautions

1. Wash/hygiene hands frequently;
2. Avoid close contact with people suffering from acute respiratory infections;
3. Avoid hugs and handshakes;
4. In social contacts, maintain a distance of at least 1 meter between people and use respiratory protection (masks);
5. Cover your mouth and nose if you sneeze or cough (sneeze and/or cough into a handkerchief, avoiding hand contact with respiratory secretions);
6. Avoid mixed use of bottles and glasses;
7. Do not touch your eyes, nose and mouth with your hands;
8. Do not take antiviral drugs and antibiotics, unless prescribed by a doctor;
9. Clean surfaces with chlorine- or alcohol-based disinfectants;
10. **If you have symptoms that can be traced back to the virus, such as a fever of over 37.5°, coughing, difficulty in breathing, runny nose, headache, sore throat, coughing, pneumonia, you should stay in your room, immediately contact 112 or the local medical service and inform Opera Universitaria by calling the following numbers: 0461/217490 - 0461/217403 - 0461/217402.**
